In modern codes, static models adopted previously, representing physically existing heavy vehicles, have been replaced by ideal models, aimed to reproduce the target. In general, end bent slopes shall be 1 1/2:1 in fill sections and 2:1 in cut and partial cut sections unless recommended otherwise by the Soils and Foundation Section. It is recommended that the vertical curves extend beyond the bridge length, where possible, to minimize the design, drainage issues, and construction complexity of the bridge structure.
