A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. In a multi-core cable the cores are twisted and change their location in space so the current unbalance between parallel cores is concealed. Individual cores= less weight easier installation. My suggested strategy would be to run the required EGC as a separate conductor, in the same tray. 10 (G) provides rules on installing conductors in parallel.
