

Do cable trays require coal mine safety regulations



Overview

The use and installation of cable trays is covered by legally enforceable OSHA regulations in 29 CFR 1910. The Mines Regulations 2014 came into force on 6 April 2015, and replace all previous health and safety mining law. Please note that L43, First aid at mines, will remain in force. Who this.
