

How to connect a pigtail for communication cascading



Overview

Pigtail connectors feature metal tines that slice through the insulation and contact the metal when compressed. So you only have to insert the pigtail and circuit wire inside, then depress the cap using a pair of pliers to push the metal tines through.
