Connecting the Wires: Once all the wires have been stripped, start by connecting the bare copper or green-insulated ground wires. If you're using a metal box, add a pigtail (a 6-inch length of the same type of ground wire) to the other ground wires and connect it to the ground. Learn how to install a junction box safely, from choosing the right box and mounting it correctly to making secure splices and following basic code-safe practices. To install a junction box correctly, choose a box that matches the wiring method and environment, mount it securely, bring cables in. Junction boxes protect electrical wires from damage, prevent shocks, and stop sparks from igniting flammable material nearby. It acts as a central connection point for various electrical wires, allowing for the easy distribution of electricity to different fixtures and devices.
