A three-phase power system is said to be balanced when the phase voltages have the same amplitude and are separated by a phase angle of 120° . Accordingly, voltage imbalance describes a variation in a power system in which the voltage magnitudes, or the phase angle differences between them, or both. Very often, the lowest-level circuit breaker does not trip, but the upstream (higher-level) one does! This causes a large-scale power outage! Why does this happen?
