Overview

A ladder type cable tray tee is a fitting used to create a branch in a cable tray system, allowing cables to be routed in three directions. Its "T" shape provides a secure and efficient way to split cables from a main tray into two separate paths, ensuring organized and flexible. Metal T-shaped branches for cable trays are specialized components designed for electrical power supply systems. The T-shaped design allows for easy integration of wires, maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. Characteristic of this steel type is that – prior to mechanical deformation – it is given a zinc coating by means of a continuous dipping process. This zinc coating is easily deformed. A cathodic action occurs on cut surfaces (up to 1. In. dia), commercial, and infrastructure projects.
