Consequently, only cables where mechanical protection is provided by a suitable sheath, for example, PVC sheathing, MICC, fire resistant cables to BS 7629-1 or steel wire armouring, can be used in conjunction with ladder and tray systems. This misconception of “emphasizing the conductor and neglecting the sheath” often maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is ect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
