

Where to insert the large-mouth pigtail cable



Overview

Identify the insertion site, which is usually the fourth or fifth intercostal space in the mid-to-anterior axillary line (just lateral to the nipple in males), immediately behind the lateral edge of the pectoralis major muscle. Instead, with a bit of force directed towards the chest wall, twist your dilator to try and catch some of the fascia, and then pull back as if to try and tear it. This will likely require a few attempts, but you. Adults: Trauma carts should be stocked with 28Fr, 24Fr, 20Fr standard chest tubes and 14Fr pigtail catheter kits.
